

IMPORTANT UPDATE AS OF 2/9/26 REGARDING MINOR PAYMENTS

A recent media report apparently indicating that payments for children's claims will be issued in the next two weeks is incorrect. First, children will not receive cash payments. The payments for those who are currently children will be issued to a trust or to an annuity company that is providing structured payments. (Some claimants who are children may be eligible to receive \$5,000 up front before putting the rest of the money in trust/structure.) Second, payments for children will not be issued until the process of confirming legal representatives and finalizing appeals for those claims is complete and after the Court authorizes a final allocation and payment distribution.

Right now, the payment administrator is issuing payments for property claims. That process is expected to continue through February. Adult injury claim payments will be issued before payments for minors. The adult injury payments can be issued only after the Court authorizes a final allocation for those claims.
